Cattlemen Address the Latest Issues at Annual Meeting

At the annual business meeting of the Kansas Cattlemen's Association, cattlemen from across the state came together to address the latest issues affecting the cattle industry. Four new resolutions were proposed by the attending membership.

The resolutions introduced by the producer members were to support and encourage the Department of Justice to review, investigate, and enforce antitrust laws of various mergers taking place in the industry, promote animal welfare, stewardship, and ownership rights, support cattle exemptions from emissions regulations, and promote producers' water rights.

Those proposed resolutions, along with other issues that were addressed will go before the KCA membership for a vote. Voting will take place by mail in ballots sent to every producer member in good standing. Ballots were mailed February 8 and every producer member will have the opportunity to exercise their right to help decide the direction of the association. Results of voting, will be available March 15, 2010.
